1. United Earth

3:07

The human race has been divided in two: the mortals, which remained in the Solar System and some distant colonies, and the wanderers, which have expanded across the stars. The terrestrial government is forced to ally itself with Utopia, one faction of the wanderers, if it wants to survive the confrontation with the suryans.



2. Fissures in reality

4:03

The crew of the explorer ship *Nereida*, goes into Limbo, a nebula that defies known physical laws. Virtually no one who has entered Limbo has came back.



3. Ocean in the sky

The planet Sedna, home to intelligent cetaceans, the narwhals, enjoyed calm until the arrival of the suryans. Almost all the animal species of its gigantic ocean died. After exploiting its resources, Surya lost interest in Sedna and abandoned it.



4. Heroes of the infinite

On the side of the allies, Valeri Ichilov and Luis Torelli symbolize the fragile cooperation between terrestrials and Utopia. The alliance, forced by circumstances, will cause great friction between humans and wanderers.



General Maksim Ichilov leaves the *Oberon* command bridge to join his son Valeri, who was seriously injured during combat. Unfortunately, his son is not a wanderer.



12. Fire on Mars

The allies meet in the orbit of the red planet to stop Surya's attack. If the fleet fails to defend Mars, the way to Earth will be clear for the enemy.



13. Renaissance

Death is only an obstacle for wanderers, if they have a digital copy of their brain that can be restored in another body. And if they have the necessary money to buy it.



14. Echoes from eternity

3:23

The study of the information rescued from the ruins of the krenyin civilization reveals the cause of its extinction, and also the secret about the origin of the universe.



15. Dance of peace

Every time humanity fights against itself, the balance is devastating. However, a ray of light shines through the embers of destruction. Our heroes have won a moment of relaxation, and the right to desire a peaceful future.

Synopsis of the novel: A new race of humans, the wanderers, has arrived to the stars. While the citizens of the Earth desperately try to find resources to survive, virtually immortal beings launch themselves into the conquest of other worlds.

And they discover that they are alone. All intelligent civilizations have disappeared, although they left behind secrets of incalculable value. What is the cause of this silence? Why did these cultures become extinct at the zenith of their existence?

The human race, confronted by itself, will seek the answer in a mysterious region of space, the Limbo, where the laws of physics seem to be different from the rest of the universe. But what awaits there is not what the human race expected to discover.

Summary of the plot:

Contains spoilers

The humanity has reached the stars. By delegation. Their descendants, the wanderers, people virtually immortal, have conquered other worlds stolen from the *homo sapiens*. The Earth and its colonies have been relegated. A new race of humans expand across the galaxy, and condescendently look at the old, decadent humanity.

But the wanderers are divided; on the one hand there is the Suryan regime, a totalitarian system that denies freedom to the wanderers, and oppresses dozens of worlds, eliminating any opposition by readjusting the personalities of the dissidents, or purging the subversive elements.

On the other hand there is Utopia, a world founded by wanderers fled from Suryan tyranny, who seek to guarantee the freedom of thought of all wanderers and build an egalitarian and prosperous nation. In theory. Their leaders begin to show the same defects of Surya's totalitarianism, and suspicions of fraud to perpetuate themselves in power.

A terrorist group of wanderers, the Third Way, attempts to change the state of things, attacking both suryans and utopians, as well as colonies of the Earth, which use wandering slaves as cheap labor in mining prospecting.

The appearance of a mysterious plague in suryan space, which only attacks the citizens of this regime, raises alarms. Is this an attack by the terrestrials? The incursion of a terrorist command in the colony of Vega forces the government of United Earth to ally with Utopia, facing the imminence of a war on a great scale. The suryans accuse the Earth of causing the conflict. Who is behind this war?

To balance the existing technological disadvantage in favor of Surya, Earth and Utopia send a scientific mission to the Limbo nebula, an area where the laws of physics seem to be different from the rest of the universe. Several thousand years ago, the Limbo was home to the krenyin civilization, which left traces of his technology in a dozen worlds. Raised on the shoulders of giants, the suryans took advantage of krenyin technology and left behind the humans and wanderers of Utopia. Penetrating the Limbo nebula is risky and only a few ships had escaped safely. In the interior it located the native world of the krenyins, which contains treasures of incalculable value, which could incline the war in favour of the allied side.

However, no one can imagine the greatest treasure in the nebula, which ultimately led to the sudden extinction of the krenyin civilization at its zenith. A treasure that receives the enigmatic name of the light of the infinite, and that will radically change our vision about the universe and the role of intelligence in the evolution of life.
